Ruth and her husband George have been members for 12 years. She has served in several leadership positions in our church. Ruth has a heart for prayer and discipleship.



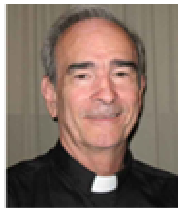
Dodie Amundson

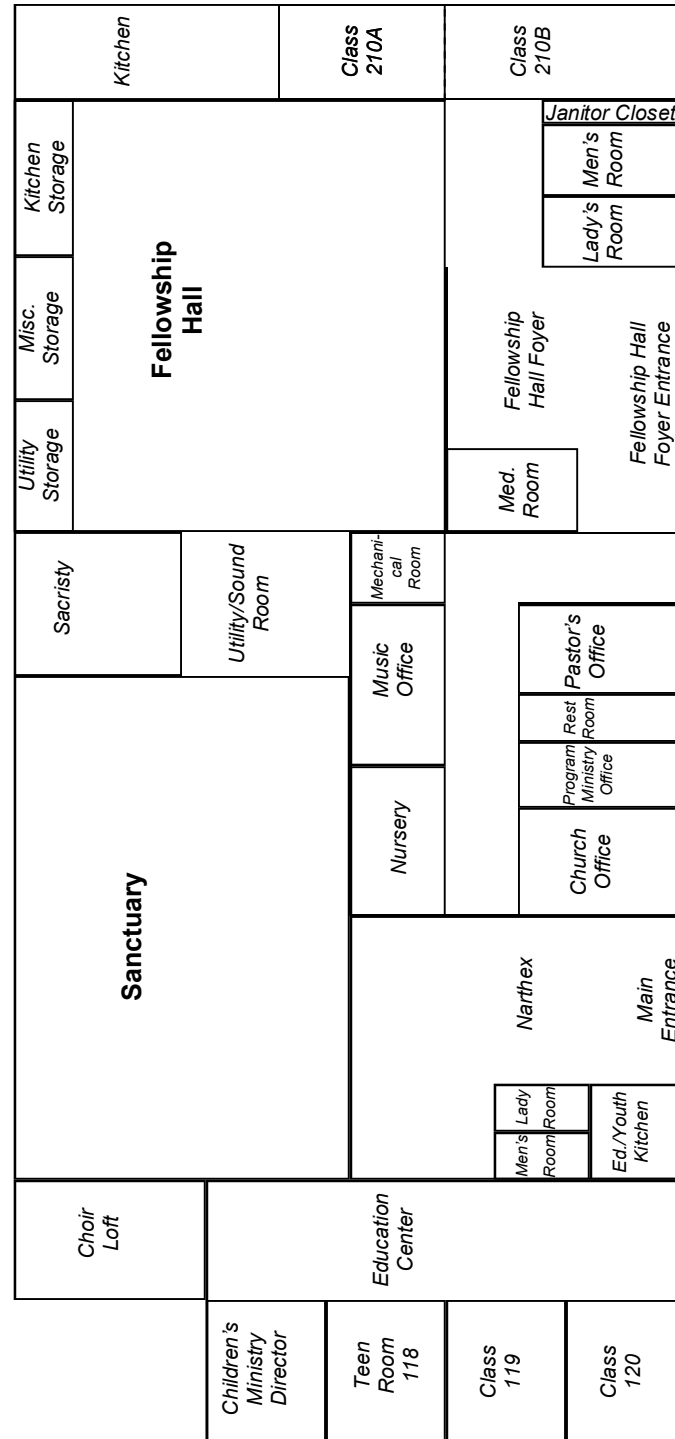


Michael Engfer
