LSSN is in need of the following items : canned goods, boxed foods, and baby food items.

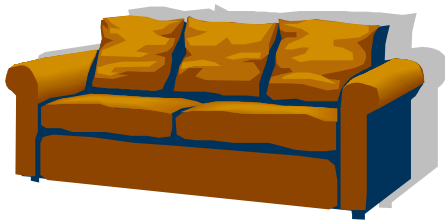
